NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Nutrient Management Plans (NMP) or required annual plan updates shall be received by Tidewater Soil and Water Conservation District staff on or before **February 15th**. Failure to meet this deadline requirement may result in a cancellation of the producer's contract(s).
- ✓ NMP balance sheets shall match current field rotations, to include cover crops and multiple nutrient applications.
- ✓ Variable Rate applications of Nitrogen and Phosphorous shall be noted in the narrative or elsewhere in the NMP, to include multiple splits of Nitrogen.
- ✓ Variable Rate applications of Nitrogen, to include multiple side dress and top-dress applications, and variable rate applications of Phosphorous require written verification, such as a prescription/recommendation, work order or bill, purchase receipts for nitrogen and/or phosphorus and an as-applied map.
- ✓ In-Furrow or Banded Applications of Nitrogen and Phosphorous require written verification, such as a District supplied reporting form, farm records, or a third-party work order* and a receipt for fertilizer purchased for the nutrient application(s) receiving a cost-share payment.

- NM-1A Private Planner –NM-1A contracts will only be accepted for producers who write their own plans or plan writers who would otherwise not meet the qualifications to write plans under DCR's Nutrient Management Direct Pay Program

 - ✓ NM-1A Statement of Plan Implementation

In addition to the requirements listed above, the producer acknowledges receipt of the 2027 VACS program specifications and acknowledges the requirement to follow all practice specifications to qualify for cost-share payment.
